- → Expense Analysis by department for FY 2016:
  - @ All expenses under budget except for IT. They are at 66.28%
- → Expense Analysis by account:
  - @ All accounts rea under except for overtime
  - Salaries are under at 41.69%
  - @ Operations is at 37.5%
  - @ Total is at 45%
- → Revenue:
  - © Current quarter received is \$17 million; year to date is \$32 million; budget is \$62.7 million; received 51% of revenue
  - @ Grants at 29%
  - @ Interest earned downtown hasn't' posted yet
  - Miscellaneous revenue is at 152%
  - © CFC year to date is at 38%
