- 1. <u>Call to Order</u>: Joseph Grasso called the meeting to order at 8:17 a.m.
- II. Changes/Additions to Agenda: Joseph Grasso no changes to agenda.
- III. <u>Approval of March 19, 2105 Airport Advisory Board Meeting Minutes</u>: Joseph Grasso requested a motion to accept the meeting minutes as written. Jon Word made the motion. D'Auna Wood seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously.

IV. Reports

Reports/Updates ~ Jim Hinde

- First round of Committee Meetings on the Sunport Master Plan. We went over the inventory and forecast portion. Our next meetings are scheduled for early July.
- Airport Managers Conference was very good and very educational.
- Daniel and I went up to Las Vegas, NV and met with Allegiant on May 6th & 7th. Fairly positive response from them on trying to start a Vegas-Albuquerque route once or twice a week depending on how many aircraft they can acquire between now and then.
- Had a conference call with Standard & Poors on Monday and we are hopeful that they are going to reaffirm the bond rating. The conference call was very positive with them.
- We were supposed to have our budget mark-up on May 14th but it was moved to May 27, 2015. We are hoping they are going to do the mark-up and the approval of the budget on the same day, because by ordinance it needs to be approved by June 1st.
- Taxiway A Phase C started. They are making pretty good progress. They almost have all of the old asphalt removed and they will start pouring concrete placement.
- Tent City showed up over the weekend and they received their eviction notice yesterday.

Finance ~ Phyllis Keller for Pam White

- Revenue for the 3rd quarter:
 - Current quarter we received \$14.6 million.
 - Year to date we received \$47 million
 - Budget is \$65.5 million
 - We are at 72% of our budget in revenues.
- Expenses by Account:
 - Salaries are at 66%
 - Operations are at 62%
 - o Transfers are at 74%
 - Other transfers are at 75%
 - Total operating expenses are at 70.5%
- Expenses by Department:
 - Administration is at 64%
 - Airfield is at 68%
 - o DEII is at 60%
 - Operations is at 60%

- Building Maintenance is at 65%
- Parking is at 66%
- o Car Rental is at 61%
- o Police is at 70%
- o IT is at 68%
- Operations is at 65% with all the added transfers we are at 70%

• Pie Chart:

- Calendar year to date enplanements for the month of March was 186,809, its down by 5.5% from the same month a year ago: deplaned for the month of March is down -7% from the same month a year ago; percentage change of a -6%.
- Sunport tower counts had a decrease of -4.2%
- DEII tower counts had a decrease -5.6%

Public Affairs ~ Daniel Jiron

- Two days of news about Santa Fe losing their LA service and the news reporter looked at a story from a year prior. They corrected the story the next day.
- K-9 ambassador program is growing. We will have 5 dogs on board.
- 1-25 closure that we were given 20 minutes notice the day before.
- Discussed the Allegiant meeting that Jim touched on.
- Jumpstart will be June 1-3, 2015 in Seattle, WA.
- Charlotte, NC service starts June 5 seasonal through September.
- Boys & Girls Club has asked us to host a plane pull for a benefit for them in September. Pulling for Kids is their slogan.
- Boutique will start flying to Carlsbad on June 1st.
- Partnering up with Albuquerque Heading Home. They will be placing change collectors at the check point.

Project Overview ~ Jack Scherer

- Re-submitting the mechanical work for bidding. Won't be starting work until November.
- Underway with taxiway A.
- Hold on parking structure lighting restart 2nd week of June. Report from Felix, Sustainability Program Manager on energy savings and it is starting to pay out even though it is not complete.
- Replacing boilers is going very well should be done by the middle of July.
- Snowbarn up and running.
- Restroom at RAC well on its way.
- Police Suite will start Tuesday.
- Fitness Center will start mid-July.
- Can start the Parking revenue system, exit booth, and office area renovation now.
- Walk through tomorrow on the DEII paving projects taxi lane bypass, reconstructed the ramp, reconstructed taxiway A-1, and extended taxiway B to the SAM's Academy.
- A couple of projects under design: employee parking lots being reconstructed, relocating the IT group
 and build out their office, renovate the Access Control Office, and fully development the family
 assistance center.
- At some point reconstruction of Spirit Drive and GA parking.
- Finally got approval for design for pre-security.

- Taxiway Alpha Phase C reconstruction but have had weather issues and cracking of the concrete has delayed the work but will start up again.
- Snowbarn replacement facility for Airfield for all weather equipment and staging for any type of event.
- 3rd week of April we had our Annual Certification Inspection and there were a few items that needed correcting and they will be done before July 22nd.
- One week from today we will be having our Runway Safety Action Team Meeting (RSAT) at 8:30am.
- In late April during our inspection we had Runway 8-26 closed for two straight weeks. While we replaced 14-16 slabs were replaced.
