Finance ~ Josh Castellano-Gonzalez

- → Middle of Budget process
- → Responses to questions due to City Council Monday (5/22/19)
- Annual Airlines Affair 6/12, PFC#6-trying to combine letter; out early May
- → PFC = Passenger Facility Charge
- → Award new IPS Security contract Secure Toss (Critical Infrastructure Services)
  - o Finalizing contract, no protests,
  - Level 3 security = armed guards; Level 1 = walk around terminal
  - o Lower hourly rate
- → Parking adding more pay stations that accept cash
  - o On-line portal
  - o Fast-pass lane
  - o Possible mobile app
  - o Start design painting project in garage
  - o Color coded
  - New signage to match what is in terminal
- → Expenses Every division within budget
  - Exception Police, who are main drivers due to mandatory OT
  - Protected by revenue diversion extra transfer to capital fund at end of year
  - o If we make extra, we keep or sometimes credited to airlines
  - o Longevity wages set by Budget, floating target
  - o Focus on total salaries
