 - Reports/Updates & Business Development ~ Director Nyika Allen
 - Announcements; Enviro grant from TAA;; RBD electric busses, due early July
 - 4-5 potential clients for our land
 - County received a chrsy grant from federal transit assoc; will help rehab old rail ??? that KAFB owns; interested in rehabbing that
 - FIRR needs to be turned over to; one option to turn over land; we may be able to take ownership of rail spurt
 - o Jay what is involved in taking ownership
 - NA will take 2 years to rehab rail; a lot of options...leasing to sublet, concession agreement;



- o From mail rail line on west side of I25 exists and working (like rail runner); spur off Bobby Foster area (south of Rio Bravo exit); canyon behind Sunport and back of Sunport behind runway
- o Marie; if we get this, will it be used to bring passengers or freight; purpose? NA still in discussion, right now freight
- o Rail spur north side of terminal Fred (:NA looking at recently, a lot of activity, easement still there; cannot put a training
- o If line there and easement there is is possible (ray); can we bring passengers to airport; Nyika too early to know; would need more information:

- o Electric buses used on loop for airport to RAC shuttle
- O Jay supplier: NA going out to bid, so cannon chose bidder; lowest bid selected with this process; trying to avoid ART bus
- Tried to get clause regarding failed contract with City in past. Peter: Are some standard protections built into RFB template that preclude bidder who have failed in K with City in last 5 years; not going to repeat history; standard provisions
- o Jay if signed today; how long before capability for busses? Na official grant award FAA first, couple months, not sure if busses have to be built with specs; Josh takes about one year to build busses; Jay; part of K includes installation of charging station? NA Yes busses and associated infrastructure

- NA a lot of work with PNM; latter stages of what a new substation will look for us; presentation from pnm last week (SAGE BRUSH name) 100 Xs better than Randolph Station; working on infrastructure; much better place than in last 50 years
 - Plan to decommission Randolph
 - NA plan is two mini substations
 - Ray backup plan; NA 10 year plan to have another substation on south side of Airport (University, Mesa del Sol)

- Excited to launch Build with Robots local teach;; autonomous disinfecting robots launched
- Deputy Director Richard McCurley (Landside)
 - COVIDi-19 preventative measures; upgrade cleaning areas, touchpoints
 - Increased # hand sanitizer stations
 - Order for sneeze guards at public facing area; ticket/gate counts; concessions, RAC
 - Social distancing signage on floor installed
 - Monday starting to distribute 250K facemasks to be distributed to public, airlines employees and aviation employees; from FAA FEMA, 3 months supply, free
 - Does airport require facemask; yes, signage; will be handing out to folks without mask
 - Looking at future regulations; associations in industry working on requires masks



- David Urioste joined team; Facilities Manager
- Jon Word What happens if someone walks in without mask; Nyika we give them a mask; Jay – enforcement; Nyika technically if we wanted to we have ability to ask them to leave the airport if they don't want to follow the rule; we have signs, airlines rules, governors orders; we would have ability to; Jon worth having conversation to be prepared and be ready; Nyika airlines have rules and internal no fly lists, if folks not complying communicate with airline; jay to Peter? Since public space, do we have legal authority to escort folks off the property? Jon or do we want to? Peter - authority we have and how we exercise it, so far in NM there have been a lot of enforcement issues; we will have authority to have folks put on mask or ask them to leave; we are required to ensure that our premises is being operated based off governor's requirement; asking someone to wear a mask; how are we going to handle this; enforcement action vs customer service route and be compliant with governors order; no confrontations yet; jay opportunity for airport to speak with police and plan for gradual escalation; jay make sure airport personnel have understanding of rules and graduated response (put mask on to escort off property; Jon not debating folks not required; Marie public health emergency dictates response; Nyika not a criminal offense; Jeremy on line
- \bullet Anthony are there announcements throughout building NA , signage and over speakers
- Jay to Jeremy synopsis
- Jeremy Bassett no criminal statute or ordinance for failure to wear mask; what stat police does (citations for criminate trespass); visual presence; private companies have right to refuse; biggest asset if that private companies deny services; if comes to point of verbal escalation, one option to criminally trespass; if you don't wear mask or leave then criminally trespassed and not allowed, then arrested; Jon exceptions in governor's order; Jeremy no statute or ordinance to charge;
- Jay police are prepared; will advise folks and provide masks
- Steve will get announcements going
- Deputy Director Steven Petty (Airside)
 - Everbridge going into implementation phases
 - Testing phase
 - o Up and running 2-4 weeks
 - KPD Kirtland partners committee; possible Avian radar; putting grant together; goes between 5-10 miles around airport; currently have 25-30 bird strikes / year; looking at being a possible sponsor
- Finance ~ Josh Castellano-Gonzalez
 - CARES grant through City Council and approved; waiting on signed docs from FAA
 - Mostly use on salaries; easier to draw down vs small invoices; best way to utilize
 - Enplanements improvements in April; April down 95.8; may down 91.3%;
 4% change; still down over 90% but improving; numbers for June look better

 - o Taxiway Echo phase II sent in this week
 - No start date
 - o Annual wildlife yesterday
 - o 139 pushed back to September
 - o Emergency Tabletop scheduled for June 30; jay can board members observe; jane will follow-up if board members can attend

 - TIP next week programming the lighting (Red, green, blue); different colors and scenes, colors changing over time for seasonal or special event (holidays); future will see lighting changes; will have capability and create light changing effects;

 - Mirror facility currently in design phase; schematic design phase; progressing; architect pushing thru review committees;

 - Air service update; SWA temp 811-9/12; JetBlue exemption dot; exited NYC thru 6/15-8/30; DOT option for them to stretch to 9/30
 - Still have Orlando route thru allegiant; tickets inexpensive
 - Business Dev/Eco development projects moving along quickly and better than anticipated; under NDA for all projects now; if to fruition nonaeronautical revenue; land leases;

 come back flight in July; united San Francisco flight; Fred June July numbers should
