 - a. Reports/Updates Richard McCurley, Director out Brian
 - Construction: Dream of flight, walls up in 2-3 weeks; capture remaining checkpoint area; open new hallway; removing roofing on concourse for overhead; fire suppression
 - ii. Generator project; punch list closed; out; fly up and running
 - iii. PC air replacement punch list; To get air to jet bridges??
 - iv. Passenger boarding bridge; preconstruction for a side and another \$7M for B side; and hope to have out to bid mid-summer;
 - v. RAC replace update sun panels; those panels should support off grid
 - vi. Parking garage pre-con next month or so close off 1/3-1/2 level at time and replace lights garage; newer fixtures; improve lighting in garage; long project; request patience garage

- 1. ABQ gaining 9 new flights in April. Total going from 65 to 74 departures per day.
- 2. Southwest adds 7 flights,
- 3. American adds 1 Austin and 1 Los Angeles,
- 4. JetBlue returns with 1 JFK,
- 5. Alaska reduced the 1 Portland flight from daily to weekends only.
- 6. Southwest plans to increase the Orlando flight from once to twice per week in October.
- 7. Spirit moved the addition of their 2nd Las Vegas flight from May back to August.
- 8. American dropping their only westbound flight from Roswell to Phoenix. Look into possibility of subsidizing Advanced Air to fly Roswell to ABQ and Farmington to ABQ.
